

Personal, Social and Emotional Development (PSED)

The children will be developing their skills in making relationships, self-confidence and self awareness and managing feelings and behaviour by:

- Playing co-operatively and taking turns
- Show sensitivity towards the feelings and ideas of other children
- Developing the confidence to try new experiences
- Develop the confidence to speak in a larger group
- Following class rules

Characteristics of Effective Learning (COEL)

Active Learning - keeping on trying

- Children will learn to show persistence with an activity and persevere when faced with challenges or difficulties and adapt their approach in order to achieve something. Children will learn how to bounce back when facing a difficulty.

Expressive Arts and Design (EAD)

The children will explore and use different media and materials and being imaginative through;

- Exploring patterns and colours
- Colour mix with paints to create different colours
- create using paints, chinks and crayons
- using musical instruments to make sounds
- learning songs and moving their body to a rhythm

Children will also continue weekly singing assemblies with KS1.

Literacy Development (LD)

The children will develop their reading and writing by;

- Daily phonics sessions
- Guided Reading group and individual sessions
- Reading words and simple sentences, including tricky words at their individual level
- Write words and sentences by sounding out and writing letters to communicate meaning
- Use finger spaces and full stops in their writing and begin to use capital letters where appropriate
- Read back their writing
- Write in a range of styles including lists, stories, labels

The children will also share a range of stories/poems/non-fiction books relating to countries and life in different parts of the world

Communication and Language (C&L)

The children will focus on listening and speaking skills and how these help us to learn through;

- Developing the skills to listen carefully in a range of situations
- Answer questions about their interests, stories and instructions
- Show and Tell sessions
- Circle Time discussions
- Using talk to clarify their thinking and feelings
- Follow multi part instructions
- Using past, present and future forms accurately

Children will also join whole school assemblies.

Understanding the World (UW)

The children will explore different countries in the world including:

- Learning about London and Penkridge
- Learning about contrasting environments and comparing life there to life where they live
- Comparing animals in different countries and their habitats

The children will continue Wellie Wednesdays and

- Look closely at similarities and differences and change

In Technology, the children will;

- Use an iPad camera to take photos
- Recognise and use a range of technology at school

Mathematical Development (MD)

The children will develop their understanding of number and shape, space and measure by;

- Counting reliably with numbers and ordering numbers
- Adding and subtracting using a range of equipment
- Solve problems using number
- Explore size, weight, time and money and capacity
- Make and compare patterns
- Use mathematical language when using 2D and 3D shapes

The children will also join in with number and counting songs and stories and continue weekly Active Maths.

Physical Development (PD)

The children will develop their fine motor skills by;

- Practising writing letters and numbers and forming them correctly
- Cutting accurately with scissors
- Use correct pencil grip

The children will develop gross motor skills by;

- PE lessons developing climbing, balancing and jumping

The children will develop self-care skills through;

- Managing their own basic personal and hygiene needs independently
- Using equipment safely
