

Cross-Curricular Literacy

Writing genres include: creating a persuasive leaflet, comparing contrasting localities, creating fact files and reports. Exploring empathy through severe weather experiences (hurricanes).
Writing narratives: linked to St Lucia.

PSHE

Dreams and Goals: What are my hopes and dreams? Explore how some of these may not come true. Which past dreams or hopes have been positive? Can I set new goals to achieve?
Healthy Me: Why do I need friends? How do I contribute to a friendship? Does my friendship group have an impact on me?

Science

Skeletons: Children learn the names of human bones and distinguish between vertebrates and invertebrates.
Rocks, Soils and Fossils: Children classify rocks and look at the make up of soils. They learn about the different types of fossils.

Geography & History

St Lucia: Where is St Lucia? Can you locate it on the World map? How is St Lucia the same and different to UK? Which languages do they speak? What is a volcano? What happens in hurricane season? Do we understand Fairtrade? (We will plan a special visit to the Co-op to look at Fairtrade!)

Desktop Publishing: Compare text and images. Edit text and change font styles. Create templates and use different layouts.
Animations: What is stop animation? Create storyboards and produce a stop animation.
