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CAN YOU WALK?

In an effort to reduce the traffic around school at the start and end of the day I ask that you consider whether you could walk your child to school.

GOVERNOR VACANCIES

We have spaces available for school governors.

There are 2 types of governors - parent governors and co-opted governors. Parent governors are those with children at the school, co-opted are those with skills that the governing board believe would be beneficial. At present there are vacancies in both categories..

The governing board meets once per term - usually Oct, Feb and June with meetings lasting approx. 2 hours.

The role of a governor is to provide challenge to the school leadership, not to make change directly themselves. There is also an opportunity to become link governors, assigned to a subject, visiting school to assess how well they are doing at delivering the curriculum and reporting findings back at the governor meetings.
